

Basic literacy and numeracy for young children in slum clusters

Nathupur Pahari Centre, Gurgaon - a slum inhabited by immigrants who earn their livelihood either by working for construction projects in Gurgaon or as domestic help.



Learning Centre before the upgrade

Grant utilized to create a semi-permanent structure of concrete boundary wall with metal pillars covered with bamboo to support the roof. 70 students enrolled with the centre out of which ~60 students attend the school regularly from Monday – Saturday





Dalil Ekta Camp, Delhi - Camp is a 16 year old urban poor settlement in Delhi of about 3000 people. Most residents have had very little education and are involved in roadside vending, construction work or as daily wage earners.

The grant was utilized to enlarge the existing structure and a tin roof was added, walls were extended, flooring redone to level the ground, and new furniture procured. The Learning Centre primarily serves as an after school programme for about 65 children in the slum. The Centre helps strengthen the children's learning at schools following a basic curriculum on the lines of the curriculum for ages 4-14 years
